Information for Makers

Sussex Craft Week is here to promote craft in Sussex: works by Sussex makers and Sussex as a central hub for craft in the UK.

Who should apply?

All professional makers, venues, independent handcraft businesses in and from Sussex. Makers from across the UK and internationally can apply to participate in certain events too.

What craft forms are covered?

All craft forms are included: ceramics, sculpture, metalwork, printmaking, paperwork, metalwork, glass, jewellery, mixed media, textiles, needlecraft, furniture. The emphasis is on skill and handcraft rather than medium.

Is this curated or an open platform?

Sussex Craft Week is part-curated, part-open. You should curate your own exhibitions and events. All events are vetted to make sure that they fit with the theme - skilled professional craft - and on the dates 20-28 June 2026.

What sort of events should we organise?

Makers exhibitions (group or solo), fairs, open studios, talks, tours, demonstrations.

Should they be free or ticketed events?

This is up to you. We provide ticketing software if you would like to charge and it is easy to use. We take a small % of ticket sales.

How much does it cost?

The fees are outlined in detail on the following page with the promotions that go with them. There are four types: Headline Exhibition, Sussex Craft Week Exhibition, Sussex Craft Week Event and Makers Event. Prices start from £50.00 and all include a subscription to ROSA Magazine.

Are prices per maker or per event?

Per event - however many makers take part.

How will my event be marketed?

All Sussex Craft Week events will appear on our online calendar and on the map with descriptions, images and links. We will send you promotional materials in digital and print formats. The Headline and SCW Exhibitions and Events have ads in our printed magazine too.

What kind of promotion are you doing for Sussex Craft Week?

We are experts at promoting the arts and will be running full marketing, PR, social media and advertising campaigns across the region and the UK.

What's the connection with ROSA?

Sussex Craft Week is organised by ROSA (Review of Sussex Arts) who publish ROSA Magazine - so joining our community allows our makers to find out more about each other.
